Fees for returning members are due by May 31 annually. Any current members who haven't registered by May 31^{st} cannot be guaranteed a place in next year's choir.

1) Main Concerts - December 3 and April 29

Our choirs perform two main concerts each year - Christmas and Spring. Barring serious illness, choristers MUST attend the two Half-Show Rehearsals, the Full-Run Rehearsal and the Concert. By registering, you are agreeing that this chorister will be available at the following times:

- Regular 5 6:00 pm rehearsals on Wednesdays, September 13 to November 29 and January 13 to April 25. Please let us know in advance if he or she has to miss a regular rehearsal. Generally we don't schedule rehearsals during Family or Easter Week.
- Half-Show Rehearsals at 5:00 pm on Wednesdays, November 22, 29, April 18 and 25
- Full-Run Rehearsals on Saturdays, 9:30 am 12:30 pm, on December 2, 2017 and April 28, 2018
- Concerts on Sundays, 1:15 4:00 pm, December 3, 2017 and April 29, 2018

2) Outreach Concerts (Dates TBA)

Outreach Concerts are important for our choristers as well as our organization:

- For some it's the challenge of testing performing skills in a different environment. For others, giving two concerts a year just isn't enough!
- When more choristers participate, everyone sings better due to the energy on stage. This means that even those singers who don't always sing loudly can still have a great impact on the look and the sound and the energy of the overall performance. No matter what, we all bring our SPIRIT!
- A lot of work has gone into learning the songs, so it's nice to perform them more than once.
- It's an opportunity for choristers to socialize.
- It's a chance for us to build awareness about inclusion and "normalize" living in community with those who have differences.
- It promotes membership in our choirs.
- Most Outreach appearances generate donations that help keep our registration fees low.

For all of the above reasons, and because our performers do better when there's a higher attendance, please seriously consider our requests for your chorister's participation in Outreach Concerts. We always poll our families well in advance of the concert date.

NOTE: If transportation to an Outreach Concert is an issue, just let us know and we'll do our best to arrange a ride for your chorister.
