◆ Regarding Fees

Fees for returning members are due by May 31 annually. Any current members who haven't registered by May 31st cannot be guaranteed a place in next year's choir.

On our website - KidsofNote.com - click on "Members" in the very bottom right corner of the page. In the Members section, follow the instructions to pay the full fee* by e-transfer or credit card. \$100 of this payment is immediately non-refundable. ***As of July 31 the full fee is non-refundable.***

A receipt for your full payment will be generated by our website.

Please advise us if Creative Kids Inc. will be paying your chorister's fee. For current members registration forms are still due by May 31, even if Creative Kids is paying your fee later.

* The fee is \$200.00 for the full year. Multiple registrations from the same family are \$175.00 each. Each registration includes 1 free Picactic ticket for each concert.

◆ Performance Requirements

• READ THOROUGHLY PLEASE •

1) Main Concerts - November 25, 2018 and April 14, 2019

Our choirs perform two main concerts each year - Christmas and Spring. Barring serious illness, choristers **MUST** attend the two Half-Show Rehearsals, the Full-Run Rehearsal and the Concert. By registering, you are agreeing that this chorister will be available at the following times:

- Regular 5:00 - 6:00 pm rehearsals on Wednesdays, September 5 to November 21 and January 16 to April 10. *Please let us know in advance if your chorister has to miss a regular rehearsal. Generally we don't schedule rehearsals during Family or Easter Week.*
- Half-Show Rehearsals at 5:00 pm on Wednesdays, November 14 and 21, April 3 and 10
- Full-Run Rehearsals on Saturdays, 9:30 am - 12:30 pm, on November 24, 2018 and April 13, 2019
- Concerts on Sundays, 1:15 - 4:00 pm, November 25, 2018 and April 14, 2019
- PLEASE write all these dates into your calendar TODAY.

2) Joy of Vox Performances and Toonie Drive - December 12, 13 & 14

Unless there are medical or environmental reasons a chorister can't attend at least one of these events to participate in the performance of one or two songs, choristers are expected to participate in this important fundraiser which adds as much as \$4,500 to our budget, keeping your fees low.

3) Outreach Concerts (Dates TBA)

Outreach Concerts are important for our choristers as well as our organization:

- For some it's the challenge of testing performing skills in a different environment. For others, giving two concerts a year just isn't enough!
- When more choristers participate, everyone sings better due to the energy on stage. This means that even those singers who don't always sing loudly can still have a great impact on the look and the sound and the energy of the overall performance. No matter what, we all bring our SPIRIT!
- A lot of work has gone into learning the songs, so it's nice to perform them more than once.
- It's an opportunity for choristers to socialize.
- It's a chance for us to build awareness about inclusion and "normalize" living in community with those who have differences.
- It promotes membership in our choirs.
- Most Outreach appearances generate donations that help keep our registration fees low.

For all of the above reasons, and because our performers do better when there's a higher attendance, please seriously consider our requests for your chorister's participation in Outreach Concerts. We always poll our families well in advance of the concert date. *NOTE: If transportation to an Outreach Concert is an issue, just let us know and we'll arrange a ride for your chorister.*

4) GPUC "Appreciation" Performance(s) (Date TBA)

The people of Grosvenor Park United have done so much to make our choirs possible and our fees low. In fact, our choirs would likely not exist if it weren't for their generosity in providing free space and bookkeeping for our first 13 years, to name just a couple of their contributions since 2005. At least once a year, by way of saying thanks, we try to have Kids of Note perform for a GPUC event. As with our Outreach Concerts, our hope is that you will do your best have your chorister attend.
